Master/Mate 100 Gross Tons

YOUR AUTHORITY

A license as Master or Mate with a near coastal restriction is good up to 200 miles offshore world wide, as well as on all inland waters, including the Great Lakes.

Because this license is not restricted by trade, you may operate passenger vessels, small cargo boats, or tugs and towboats within your route and tonnage limitation.

In addition to having the authority which is stated on the face of your license, you also have the following authority:

- A Master of Mate license authorizes service as Operator of Un-inspected Passenger Vessels, within the limits of the license.
- A Master license allows service as Operator of Un-inspected Passenger Vessels, within any restrictions on the license, provided you are at least 21. A Mate license authorizes you to serve as Second Class Operator within the limits of your license,
- A Master license allows service as Operator of Un-inspected Towing Vessels, within any restrictions on the license, provided you are at least 21. A Mate license, provided you are to serve

as Second Class Operator within the limits of your license, provided you are at least 19.

• *On inspected vessels you will be limited to power-driven vessels only, unless your license is endorsed for sail or auxiliary sail. The qualifying service for these endorsements is explained in each license category.*

• *Licenses may be limited to less than 100 gross tons, depending on the size of vessels on which you gained experience.*

APPLICATION

To obtain the Operator License, you must have:

- Application
- Original Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Physical Examination
- Drug Test
- Documentation of Service
- First Aid and CPR Certification

MINIMUM AGE

You must be at least 18 years old to apply for Mate, 19 years old to apply for Master (Near Coastal), and 21 to apply for Master (Oceans).

PHYSICAL STANDARDS

You must have normal color vision, uncorrected vision of at least 20/200 in each eye correctable to 20/40, and no serious health problems.

Ask about a waiver if you fail these standards.

SERVICE REQUIRED

Three Months of the requirements outlined below must be acquired within three years prior to application.

FOR MASTER, 100 GROSS TONS, (Near Coastal):

- 720 days (480 "12 hour" days) of total service on ocean or near coastal routes. (Service on inland or Great Lakes may substitute for up to 50% of the required service.) You can qualify for this license without having to any time as mate, but in order to raise the tonnage limitation over 100 gross tons, you must serve a year as a Master and complete additional exam topics.
- To obtain an endorsement on this license for sail or auxiliary sail vessels, you must have 12 months of service may have been obtained prior to issuance of your Master license.
