A cold, snowy greeting from all of us at Portland Yacht Services. Spring is only a few months away, and it's time to renew your seasonal marina contract.

Although our administrative offices have moved down the street, PYS will continue to manage the marina at 58 Fore St. Although there is a rate increase, we have made every effort to keep costs as low as possible. As always, the seasonal services listed below include one vehicle parking pass and use of shore facilities.

- 25 foot slips – \$2,250
- 30 foot slips – \$2,700
- Larger vessel dockage – \$90 per foot (same rate as finger docks). There is 400 feet of dock space for this purpose.
- Moorings – \$2,500. Includes dinghy tie up (max length 10 feet).
- Dinghy-only tie up – \$795 (10 foot max).
- Dry sail – \$1,000 (max length 16 feet).
- Transient mooring – \$45 per day/ \$275 per week for vessels up to 60 feet (call for larger vessels).
- Transient docking – \$2.25 per foot, hourly holdover rate \$0.50/foot
- Additional parking pass – \$125/150 per month (location-dependent), \$10 per day.

PYS has a limited number of shore power stations. If your vessel might need dedicated power, please indicate so in the Comments section of the agreement (lower-right) along with the amperage requirement. We cannot guarantee power availability but will make every effort to accommodate your needs. If dedicated power is made available, a surcharge will be assessed. To reserve your slip, please return the following by Tuesday, March 31.

- Completed contract,
- Payment of at least 50% of seasonal rate, and
- Copy of vessel liability insurance.

Slip and mooring assignments will begin April 1. Remaining docks and moorings will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. We will do our best to accommodate all requests.

Parking permits (one vehicle) and key fobs for showers/heads/laundry will be available for pick up starting May 1 (\$20 deposit required per key fob).

The P3 entrance is directly across from the Casco Bay Bridge southbound onramp.
